

As Salam-o-Alaikum wa rahmatullahi wa barakatuhu. My name is Abdullah Shah, I am 13 years old, and I am graduating from Salam Academy after being here for 7 years. William Arthur Ward said that "The mediocre teacher tells. The good teacher explains. The superior teacher demonstrates. The great teacher inspires." We are blessed to have "Great Teachers" here at Salam Academy, from whom I learned many surahs with the meaning, duas, and hadith. I also learned the Seerah of the Prophet Muhammad (SAW), and the stories of his Sahaba. I learned many words in Arabic and how to read and write it. I learned how our universe was created and how we human beings have barely any knowledge of what exists in the universe. I remember the big change from having just one teacher teaching all subjects into different teachers teaching different subjects. I learned punctuation and how to write essays and speeches like this one. I learned how to play soccer, football, tennis, and dodge ball from my classmates and teachers.
