- Sandia Prep plans to charge about \$1.740 per month.
- Saint Pius H.S. plans to charge about \$1,177 per month for non-members and about \$977 per month for members.
- The Solomon Schechter/Jewish Day School of Albuquerque about \$1,157 per month
- The UNM Child Care Center about \$900 in average per month (toddler-Pre-K)
- The UNM After School Program about \$285 per month (without the bus)
- Albuquerque Academy tuition for 2011-2012: \$1,845 per month, including lunch.
- Salam Academy's tuition for 2011-2012: \$435/ month for Middle School, \$405/ month for Elementary School, \$455 for Pre-K, \$659/ month for 1-2 year olds and \$250/ month for summer school. Part time option are also available in 1-4 year old's programs.







